
Oak Park Gymnastics

Christian Dvorak


St. Charles Gymnastics Academy




Palmer's Gymnastics



Legacy Gymnastics


Kenneth has trained gymnastics for over 14 years with Legacy Gymnastics. He is a 3x national qualifier with multiple top-10 finishes.

Gym America



Cooper Brinsko


Ohio Gymnastics Institute

Ohio Gymnastics Institute



Gymnastics World






Max Lozinak
